- Developing the lot into a park would be a great opportunity for community involvement
- People are already offering their time and resources to assist

- A house next to him would block his view as all his front windows face the lot
- He wanted to purchase the lot years ago, but was told it would never be sold
- Would request stipulations be put on the development of the lot – distance from property line etc. or give him an option to buy a portion of the lot

## Peter Loewen (147 Conner Hill Drive)

- Lot gets used regularly by people walking
- Questioned whether it had been offered by someone to purchase? (Council replied no, it has just gotten too expensive in holding costs)
- Would be a shame to get rid of a park

## Wayne Benedet (151 Conner Hill Drive)

- City needs prairie land
- City made promise 5 years ago need to follow through
- Does not have to be a trade off in regards to using the funds of selling this lot to pay for new Conner Hill Park.

- Have to review landscape plan of Morden as a whole
