

TOWN OF MORDEN

By-law No. 4-00

BEING a By-law of the Town of Morden prescribing a fee chargeable for the issuance of tax certificates.

WHEREAS Section 341(1) of The Municipal Act, being chapter M225 of the Continuing Consolidation of the Statutes of Manitoba, provides as follows:

341(1) "On request and payment of a fee prescribed by by-law, a designated officer must issue a tax certificate";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable and in the best interest of the Town of Morden to prescribe a fee chargeable for tax certificates furnished by the Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of Section 341 of the said Municipal Act:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Morden, in open Council duly assembled enacts as a By-law as follows:

***1. THAT** the fee payable for furnishing a tax certificate shall be Ten (\$10.00) dollars with respect to the land described in each entry in the tax collector's roll.

2. THAT the fees collected for issuing tax certificates be paid to the Secretary-Treasurer.

3. THAT By-law No. 1-87 of the Town of Morden be and the same is hereby repealed as at the 25th day of April, A.D. 2000.

4. THAT this By-law No. 4-00 shall take full force and effect on the 25th day of April, A.D. 2000.
