Purpose:

Requests to repair or remove snow from private approaches are received on a regular basis. Residents assume that because the Town owns that portion of land from the property line to the curb we should be responsible for snow clearing and maintenance of the approach. In the past approaches were paved or repaired however due to numerous complaints and excessive costs this practise was discontinued.

The purpose of this Policy is to have written documentation in place.

Policy:

1. Residents that request repairs or maintenace to their approach(es) would be made aware of the Town's Policy.
2. Requests to have snow removed from an approach **due to occuring snow fall or blowing snow** will be denied.
3. When street work is done in regards to ice cutting or watermain breaks, approaches will be cleaned **as soon as possible**.
4. Exceptions would be made where a major blizzard causes unreasonably large amounts of snow to be pushed into approaches as a result of the Town's normal snow plowing procedure's. e.g. previously four (4) to five (5) foot windrows would be removed by Town forces.
