

130 - 7th Street - Kenmor Theatre



This Art Deco Style building was built originally to host live theatre. Ernie Kendall Sr. started construction on the Kenmor in 1951. Ernest W. Kendall took over the business following his father's death, and completed the building in 1952, operating the Kenmor mainly as a movie theatre. The Kenmor replaced the old Starland Theatre, which was the Town's movie house until 1952.

Stan M. Jenkins, Optometrist, had his office above the theatre until he moved to the Morden Medical Clinic in 1963. Since then the office space has been occupied by a succession of businesses including a beauty shop operated by Tanya Giesbrecht. Vicki Pfeiffer purchased the building and in 2002 the theatre reverted to the vision of its builder and featured live theatre performances by both local and national artists.
