

142 - 6th Street



Dating from about 1905, the interior of this home shows that it is composed of two distinct structures, one of which was built by T.J. Warnkon, a machinist.

The style on the left is Gothic Revival – note the steep peak which identifies this style which was common in Southern Ontario.

The style on the right is Modest Italianate – which was popular in eastern Canada around the 1890's. The bay window and tall narrow windows grouped together identifies this style.
