

30 Stephen Street – Former Morden & District Hospital



Original Construction Date: Built 1952

This site was home of the Spangelo Nursery until the property was purchased as the site of the Morden and District General Hospital, and the Spangelo family moved Morden Nurseries to four mile corner.

“The Health Services Act” of 1945, which made provision for the issue of municipal debentures for the construction of hospitals, together with provincial and federal grants for construction presented a financing opportunity for a new hospital and nurses residence in Morden. The Morden and District General Hospital was opened on July 18, 1952 in conjunction with the 70th anniversary of the Town.

After many renovations and expansions to accommodate a growing population and improved technology, the hospital was closed in 2001 when the Boundary Trails Regional Health Centre replaced both the Morden and Winkler hospitals. The building at this site is now home to a variety of community services.
