Interesting roof lines and windows characterize this large residence which is a good example of a “Four Square” style house. This home was originally built for S. Pickel an auctioneer in 1904. 100 years later an auctioneering couple, Bevan & Sandra Wiebe, purchased it. Restoration began in 2004 and was completed in 2006.

The corner of 9th & Thornhill is also known and remembered as having a Town Water Pump for the neighborhood.
