Built in 1895, this well preserved modest Queen Anne Style frame house boasts a fascinating design, intricate wood trim and an interesting semi round window. The house was built for Walter Haley, banker and broker.

Large 2½ storey houses in Morden were often more elaborately finished than 1½ story residences. This home is distinguished by the moulded window surrounds, turned verandah posts, a broad cornice. Roof brackets, a bay window and an unusual tiny window on the east side.
